We spent over \$10,000+ in bushes and landscaping in the back yard alone!

The back yard is lined with Skip Laurel Plants (They are evergreen and grow approximately 8 ft tall). Were put in for privacy.

Here are the following trees we had planted:

- (4) Japanese Cryptomeria (evergreen at back of yard)
- (2) Cleveland Flowering Pear Trees (corners of back yard) non-fruit bearing. White flowers in spring.
- White Yoshino Japanese Cherry Tree (1) - same tree as along the National Mall in Washington DC
- Jane Magnolia Tree (1) w/white flowers
- (2) Flowering Thundercloud Plum Trees (pink flowers Spring)
- A line of Emerald Green Thuja (arbor vitae family) along fence
- Purple PJM Rhododendron (1) next to deck
- Variegated Japanese Maple Tree near deck
- (4) Golden Mops

Also, along the pond, we have black-eyed susans that come up behind pond near house and a beautiful purple flowering bush that comes up every spring in the front of the pond next to the Mockorange bush.

We also have:

- A Flowering Dogwood Tree (front yard center) w/beautiful white flowers in spring.
- Double Knock Out Roses (pink roses - usually bloom twice a season)
- A Beautiful Red Japanese Ornamental umbrella maple front corner of house
- Various bushes (Holly) front yard.

We will miss the Spring here as the yard landscape is BEAUTIFUL!!! And we will miss the sunsets here... they are stunning!
